Local historians Erik Eckilson and Irene Blais will trace the growth of Woonsocket from a sleepy farming community to one of the nineteenth century's great industrial centers. We will explore three historic districts and many sites individually listed on the National Register of Historic Places including Market Square, Main Street, Depot Square, the Bernon Mill Village and River Island Park.

Directions

From Providence and points South, take Route I-95 North or Route I-295 North to Route 146 North. From Boston and points North, take Route I-95 South to Route I-295 South to Route 146 North. Stay on 146 North (avoid Routes 99, 122, and 146A). Exit on Route 104 North. Continue straight at intersection with Route 146A. Route 104 becomes Providence Street, and then turns right onto South Main Street. Follow signs to the Visitors Center and Museum of Work & Culture. Parking is in the center of Market Square. We will meet at the Market Square Pavilion in Market Square on the corner of South Main Street and River Street.
